General Guidelines for Completing Application

Who is eligible: 12th-grade students (high school, technical school or home-schooled) who are residents of Charlton, Mass.

Three methods of submission:

1. Complete this **online form** and submit **by 4/30/26**. (If your references and transcript are to be submitted by US Mail, they must be postmarked by 4/30/26. If they are emailed, they must be received by 4/30/26.) If your answers are too long for this online form, note in a question's answer space that you will send it via email. Your email must say "Scholarship Application for [your name]" in the subject line. The body of the email must start with your name, and the question(s) you are answering, and continue with your answer(s).
2. Download, complete, print, scan PDF and **email** this form to thecharltonlions@gmail.com **by 4/20/26**. *Please type or print clearly*. Your email must say "Scholarship Application for [your name]" in the subject line. If your answers are too long for the space allotted, you will need to use a separate sheet for your longer answers.
3. Download, print, complete and submit by **US Mail by 4/30/26** to Charlton Lions, PO Box 1072, Charlton, MA 01508. If your answers are too long for the space allotted, you will need to use a separate sheet for your longer answers.

The committee will not consider incomplete applications. Please make sure all parts of your application (including references and transcript) are received by the due date.
